

Royal Canadian Legion Windermere District #71 HOUSE RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules were developed to ensure a safe and secure environment for members and their guests.

Members and guests are expected to treat each other with respect in the spirit of comradeship upon which the Legion was founded.

- 1. Members are permitted to introduce and sign in five (5) guests each.
- 2. Members signing in guests are responsible for the conduct of their guest(s) The guest book must be properly signed by each guest and their sponsor.
- 3. Neither foul language, crude gestures nor intoxication will be tolerated. Offenders must leave the premises on demand.
- 4. All liquor sold on the premises shall be consumed therein and no liquor sold may be taken out of the premises with the exception of bottled wine. Wine may be taken home if it has been resealed by the bartender.
- 5. Members only are entitled to purchase off sales beer.
- 6. No liquor other than sold by the licensed holder under the authority of the license shall be brought into the premises.
- 7. No liquor shall be sold or otherwise supplied on credit.
- 8. Hours of operation will be set by the branch but are not to exceed those authorized by the Liquor Control Branch on our license.
- 9. All members and guests must leave the premises within 30 minutes of last call.
- 10. Any complaints must be made in writing to the Secretary withing forty-eight (48) hours.
- 11. The bartender on duty is in charge of the lounge. They will ensure all guests are properly signed in and identified. Further, the bartender may for just cause, refuse admittance or service to any member or guest.
- 12. Fighting in the lounge will result in an automatic lounge suspension of three (3) days for member and/or guests involved.
- 13. Members are expected to assist staff in the event staff are unable to handle a troublesome situation.
- 14. No underage person will be allowed in the lounge during hours of operation.
- 15. Members who sign in minors will be suspended.
- 16. Clean and tidy clothing will be worn at all times in the Legion.
- 17. Visiting from one table to another will not be permitted except by request.
- 18. The wearing of a hat, other than authorized under the Human Rights Act for religious or medical reasons, is not permitted in the branch.
