



Windermere District Branch 71 HOUSE RULES AND REGULATIONS



These rules are designed to enhance the atmosphere for the enjoyment of our members, their guests and our visitors. All Members and guests (patrons) are asked to be respectful and cooperate in assisting staff to conduct the affairs of the Legion in an orderly and civil manner.

Member, Guest and Visitor Responsibilities

1. The bartender is entrusted with the full executive authority of the Legion. They will ensure all guests are properly signed in and may for just cause refuse admittance or service to any member or guest.
2. All patrons and staff must comply with all current Liquor Control and Licensing Act, its policies and laws.
3. The guest book must be legibly signed by each guest and their sponsoring member. Sponsors are responsible for the conduct of their guests.
4. Animals, except for service animals, are not permitted in the Legion.
5. Headdress, other than authorized by the Human Rights Act for religious, medical reasons or approved by Executive Committee, is not permitted in the branch and subject to bartender enforcement.
6. Other than off sales, liquor sold on the premises shall be consumed therein and no liquor sold may be taken out of the premises except bottled wine resealed by the bartender.
7. Only Members are entitled to purchase off sales, no credit is allowed.
8. No liquor, food or drinks shall be brought into the premises unless specifically authorized.
9. Patio access is through the Lounge.
10. There is ZERO tolerance for foul language, crude gestures, harassment or intoxication. Offenders must leave the premises on demand.
11. Informal complaints must be made in writing to the Legion #71 Club Manager within forty-eight (48) hours of an incident to be reported.
12. Patrons are subject to immediate suspension and removal of privileges if rules are not complied with or conduct is not appropriate to the best interest of the Legion and the enjoyment of patrons. Offenders are entitled to a hearing for consideration of reinstatement.
13. Patrons are expected to respect each other's privacy and personal space.
14. The area behind the Bar is out of bounds to all members and guests except the Executive Committee, and volunteers in the course of their duties.
15. Patrons must leave the premises 30 minutes after last call.
16. Members and supporters of gangs or groups that promote violence and hate will be denied access. The wearing of outlaw gang colors is not permitted.
