

JONES, JOHN A. (JACK)



Jack was born July 11, 1919 in Invermere. He enlisted with his brother Carl in September 1940, and served with the Canadian Forestry Corps in Scotland. His war bride came to the valley with him in 1945, but was homesick so she returned to Scotland. Their daughter Veronica died at age four.

A passionate outdoorsman, Jack spent most of his life in the valley as a guide outfitter. He partnered with Carl in a trucking business, hauling wood, minerals and Christmas trees. He later married Honny and their children are Kathi, Frank, and Wayne. Jack died Oct. 11, 2007.
