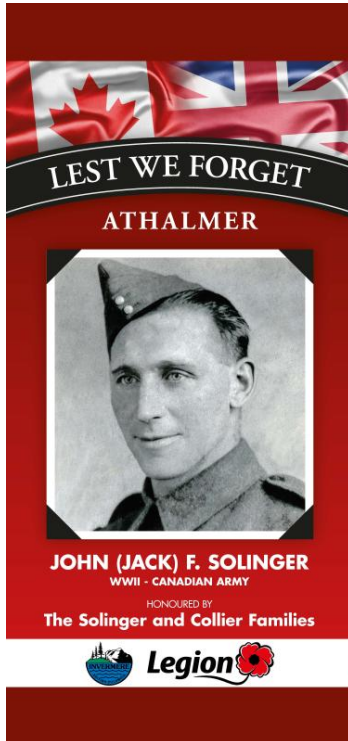


SOLINGER, JOHN (JACK) F.



Jack was born Sept. 27, 1911 in Star City, Saskatchewan, leaving home at the age of 14. He joined the Canadian Army in 1942 and became a Lieutenant-Corporal. He served in the United Kingdom and Europe with the Duke of Connaught's Own Rifles, taking part in the Battle of Caen in France. After the war he returned to his previous employer, Simon Ronacher Lumber Company in Invermere, and later worked at Revelstoke Sawmills in Radium. He was a Legion member for 45 years. Jack married Joan and they had one daughter, Louise. He died in Invermere on July 18, 1991.
