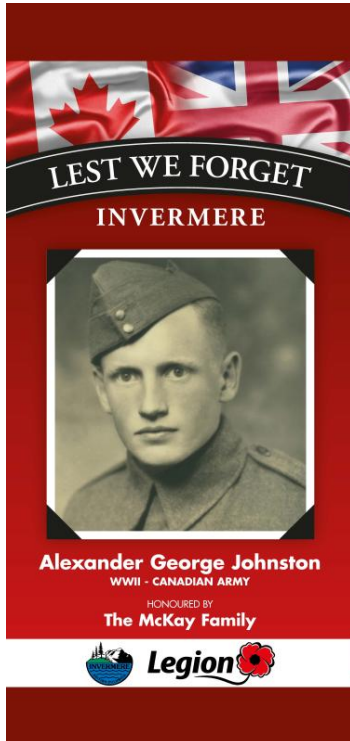


JOHNSTON, ALEXANDER GEORGE (JIGGER)



Jigger was born in Invermere Sept. 28, 1921. He enlisted in the Canadian Army in 1940 and joined the Eighth New Brunswick Hussars as a trooper and tank operator. He served overseas from 1941 in the United Kingdom, Italy, France and Greece, later joining an armoured tank division as a gunner. He married Elsie after the war and was a much-loved step-grandfather. He worked as a grader operator, and in a lumber mill. He loved the outdoors, especially hunting and trapping. He enjoyed people and liked to play badminton, cribbage and pool. Jigger died in Invermere on Feb. 2, 2005.
