


FISHER, ANTHONY



Tony was born March 19, 1911, and enlisted in Cranbrook in 1941 in the Canadian Army. He went overseas in 1943 and served as a gunner, and was later promoted to Lance-Bombardier. He served in England, Sicily and Italy. He married Sophie and they had four children. After the war Tony worked for the Wilder Brothers Lumber Company, was a farmer and mechanic, and often helped people repair their vehicles. He served as a councillor for the Columbia Lake Band, also known as the Akisqnuq Band. He was killed in a car accident on Oct. 20, 1965.
