
JIMMY, LUCIEN



Lucien was born Dec. 23, 1913, a member of the Columbia Lake Band, also known as the Akisqnuk Band. He attended St. Eugene Residential School near Cranbrook. He enlisted in 1941 and served with the Canadian Forestry Corps in Scotland; and then in the Mediterranean, Italy, Belgium, Holland, Germany and France. He served on the front lines and was wounded in 1945 before being honorably discharged. He and his wife Christine had six children: Anne, Martina, Lucien, Sam, Francis, Mary, and Margaret. After the war he worked as a horse logger with his father. He died Dec. 9, 1962.
