
MICHEL, ABRAHAM



Abraham was born May 17, 1919, a member of the Columbia Lake Band, also known as the Akisqnuk Band. He enlisted in 1941 and was trained in artillery in Vernon, B.C. and Brandon, Manitoba, before going overseas in 1943. By war's end he was an anti-aircraft gunner. Abraham returned to Canada aboard the Queen Elizabeth in 1945. After the war, he worked as a logger. He had a wonderful sense of humour. Never married but a devoted uncle, he would get two children to race for a dollar bill, then rip it in half and give half to each contestant. He died Jan. 1, 1967.
