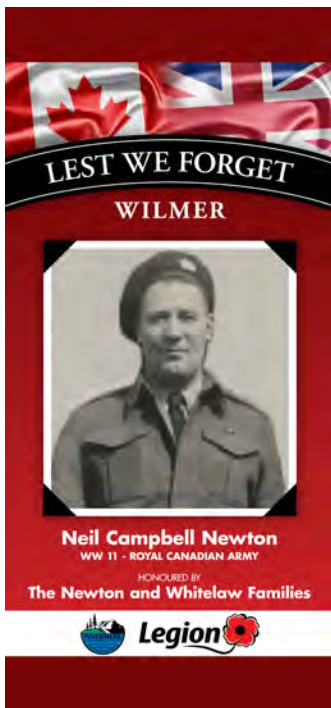


NEWTON, NIEL CAMPBELL
