Dave was born Oct. 25, 1913. He enlisted in the Canadian Army in 1940, went to England in 1941, and then to Europe in 1944. He saw action at D-Day in Normandy, was promoted to Lance Corporal, and served in several countries with the occupational troops. He married Ruby in England, and they arrived in Wilmer in May 1946. Their children were Audrey, Raymond, Joyce, and Pamela. Dave first started driving teams at the age of six, and remained an avid horseman all his life. He owned a small ranch near Wilmer, and worked in local sawmills. Dave died May 26, 1993.
