
NIXON, JOHN (JACK)



Jack was born in Wilmer on Aug. 17, 1911. He enlisted in the Canadian Army in July 1940 and went overseas in 1941 with the First Canadian Scottish Regiment. He served in England and then went to Europe in 1944, obtaining a promotion to Corporal. He fought at Normandy on D-Day and then in Belgium, Holland, France and Germany. Jack was discharged in November 1945. He never married. Upon his return, he worked in his father's guiding-outfitting business and was then employed as a logger. While working in Parson, he was killed by a falling tree on July 15, 1974.
