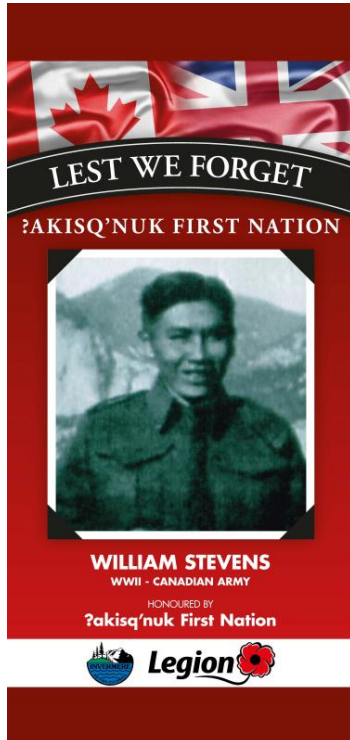


STEVENS, WILLIAM WOLFHEAD



William was born in 1916 in Tobacco Plains near Grasmere, B.C., part of the Ktunaxa Nation. He attended St. Eugene Residential School, later moving to the Shuswap Reserve at Windermere. Before the war he married a Shuswap woman, who died while he was overseas. They had one son who was raised by his aunt. William joined the Canadian Army and served as a Private with the Royal Canadian Engineers. He later married Anastasia, and their children were George and Barbara. He worked at logging with the Wilder Brothers Lumber Company, and did some farming. William died Oct. 16, 1985.
