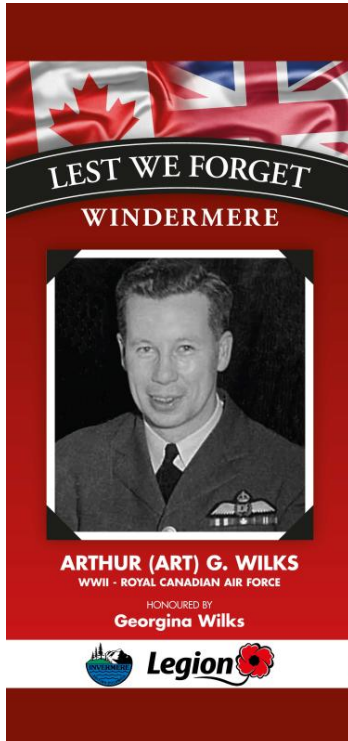


WILKS, ARTHUR G. (ART)



Born on July 10, 1923 and raised in Montreal, Art served in the Royal Canadian Air Force for 17 years. During World War Two he was a fighter pilot in England, Holland and Germany. Post-war he continued flying with the air force, then earned his doctorate and pursued a career in Human Resource Management, which included teaching at universities in Alberta and British Columbia.
